I specially thank all the members of staff and students of the faculty for their support and cooperation towards moving the faculty forward in spite of the numerous challenges facing the University.


To the members of the Editorial Team, I say thank you for ensuring that this edition of the newsletter is out.

### **Department of Animal Science**

On 3rd November, 2016, a Workshop was successfully organised by the **Department of** Animal Science in collaboration with the Postgraduate School for all Research (Postgraduate) students.

The Workshop was declared open by the Dean; Faculty of Agriculture & Forestry, Professor B. O. Omitoyin (Chief Host), HOD, Animal Science, Professor O. J. Babayemi was the Host. ### **Department of Aquaculture and Fisheries** Management

The Department organised training on integrated aquaculture in two communities. At Ile Ogbo Over 90 Farmers drawn from the Ile Ogbo and surrounding communities in Osun state were trained on Sustainable Integrated Fish and Rice cum Pig farming: Economic, Social and Environmental Assessment in the first week of February, 2016; from Tuesday, 02 to Thursday, 04 February, 2016. This is the piggery component of the project domiciled in the Department of Aquaculture and Fisheries Management University of Ibadan. The trainees were fish, crop and livestock farmers who were keen on boosting their finances by making their sources of income more dynamic and secured.
