## Events

### Department of Animal Science

On 3rd November, 2016, a Workshop was successfully organised by the **Department of Animal Science** in collaboration with the Postgraduate School for all Research (Postgraduate) students.

The Workshop was declared open by the Dean; Faculty of Agriculture & Forestry, Professor B. O. Omitoyin (Chief Host), HOD, Animal Science, Professor O. J. Babayemi was the Host. Also, in attendance were Professor Aderinto, Dean, Postgraduate School, Professor E. A. Iyayi, Registrar/CEO NIAS and immediate former Dean, Faculty of Agriculture & Forestry, Professor O. O. Olorunnisola (Immediate former Dean, PG School) among others.

### Department of Aquaculture and Fisheries Management

The Department organised training on integrated aquaculture in two communities. At Ile Ogbo Over 90 Farmers drawn from the Ile Ogbo and surrounding communities in Osun state were trained on Sustainable Integrated Fish and Rice cum Pig farming: Economic, Social and Environmental Assessment in the first week of February, 2016; from Tuesday, 02 to Thursday, 04 February, 2016. This is the piggery component of the project domiciled in the Department of Aquaculture and Fisheries Management University of Ibadan. The trainees were fish, crop and livestock farmers who were keen on boosting their finances by making their sources of income more dynamic and secured.

### The Department of Agric. Economics (AGE),

Facilitated the training of STATA (Statistics package) for staff and students in conjunction with IFPRI under the NAPP project. The Department also hosted Dr Michael Olabisi from Pepperdine University, USA who spent 3 weeks training students on R, a statistical tool.

**A**t Oyan town, Over 150 farmers were trained in the art of integrated aquaculture at the Oyan Township Hall, Oyan, Odo Otin local government Area of Osun State from 7-9 March, 2016. The training which was themed Integrated Fish and Rice cum Poultry Production: Economic, Social and Environmental Assessment, was Hosted by the Local Government Chairman and Flagged opened by the

Chief of Staff to the Governor of the State of Osun. The trainees, mainly youths and women, were taught how to simultaneously produce fish, rice and poultry on the same piece of land. The lectures also included sections on value addition and market access. The lectures were followed by practical sections to drive home the lessons.
